Blue Campaign to Help Combat Human Trafficking:

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") is responsible for investigating human trafficking, arresting traffickers, and protecting victims. In its efforts to combat human trafficking, DHS created the Blue Campaign - a collaboration with law enforcement, government, non-government and private organizations to raise public awareness about human trafficking, and educate the public to recognize human trafficking and report suspected instances.

The Blue Campaign also offers training to law enforcement and others to increase detection and investigation of human trafficking, and to protect victims and bring suspected traffickers to justice. A specific hospitality toolkit was created to provide resources and tools to share with hotel staff to help them detect the warning signs of human trafficking and report suspected activity to law enforcement.
