around the city. Capital Bikeshare makes exploring the city a breeze by putting over 2,500 bicycles at their fingertips. Designed for short trips where users can grab a bike from any station and return it to any of the 300 stations in DC, Arlington, Alexandria and Montgomery County, MD. The first 30 minutes of every trip is free with options to join for a day, 3 days, a month or year. Through Capital Bikeshare bulk membership purchases, hotels can receive discounts up to 50 percent off the regularly priced 24-hour day membership, based on the amount of passes purchased.

The DC Circulator is a great option for visitors to explore the city for only \$1 per trip. Buses arrive every 10 minutes and frequent popular DC destinations in neighborhoods including Woodley Park/National Zoo, Adams Morgan, Union Station and Georgetown. The DC Circulator is expanding its service to the National Mall beginning spring 2015. The route will begin and end at Union Station and loop around the Mall and Tidal Basin, stopping steps away from the most popular memorials, monuments and museums.

The goDCgo team is available for consultations with hotels, meeting planners, tour operators and businesses to provide customized information on sustainable transportation options near hotel property or event venue.
