## HAWDC Testifies at Council Hearings on E911 Bed Tax:



As you are aware, as part of her Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, Mayor Bowser has proposed to impose a tax upon all hotels of \$0.50 per room or suite rental, per night. This new bed tax would be an additional tax on top of what hotels already significantly contribute to the E911 fund. HAWDC testified at two hearings, the first held by

the Committee on the Judiciary and Public Safety, and the second held by the Committee on Finance and Revenue, against the proposed bed tax.

HAWDC expressed that travelers to our city generate substantial revenue for the District. Last year alone, travelers generated over \$273 million in tax collections, translating to increased job opportunities for District residents as well as assisting the District's ability to provide services. As one of the highest taxed industries in the District, there is no reasonable rationale on why travelers, who have a tangential use of the E911 system, should be charged an additional bed tax for this fund. HAWDC will continue to meet with Councilmembers to voice our concerns regarding this proposed bed tax and urge them to not levy it. As customary, we will update members as this proposal works its way through the legislative process.
