Councilmember Introduces Bill to Ban Plastic Straws:

On Tuesday, July 10th, Councilmember Jack E v a n s introduced the "Sustainable Straws and Stirrers Amendment Act of 2018." This bill seeks to prohibit the sale, use, or provision of non-compostable straws and stirrers.



Several U.S. cities have already banned plastic straws, Seattle being the largest city whose ban took effect July 1st. HAWDC is also aware that some of our members are in the process of phasing out the use of single-use plastic straws. The bill is scheduled to have a full public hearing this fall when the Council returns from its recess. If passed, the bill would become effective in early 2019. HAWDC will continue to monitor this bill as it works its way through the legislative process and will update members accordingly.

Reminder to File Second-Quarter Statements with ABRA:

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) is reminding alcohol-licensed restaurants and hotels to file second-quarter statements with ABRA by Monday, July 30, 2018. Second-quarter statements are required to report sales and expenses for food and alcohol from April through June. Statements are to include:

- Gross sales receipts for food and alcohol
- Total expenses for the purchase of food and alcohol

Restaurants and hotels are required to meet annual gross food sales of: 1) \$2,000 per occupant or 45% of annual gross receipts for a class C license; or 2) \$1,500 per occupant or 45% of annual gross receipts for a class D license. Hotel sales requirements are based on dining room occupancy.
