Sports Wagering at ABC Licensed Establishments:

Through the "Sports Wagering Lottery Amendment Act of 2018," the District Government authorized licensed and regulated sports wagering in the District of Columbia.

The District's Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration ("ABRA") is proactively reaching out to ABC licensees to provide clarity on the application and public notification process. The addition of any sports wagering kiosks or mobile terminals to an ABC licensed establishment may constitute a "substantial change" in operation, and would require advance approval from the ABC Board ("Board").

Notice of all received applications that the Board considers to be a substantial change will be given to all legally required parties, including affected Advisory Neighborhood Commissions ("ANCs"). Applicants are also required to post two placards in a conspicuous place on the outside of the establishment during the 45-day protest period. Applications may be protested and the steps for doing so are detailed at abra.dc.gov.

The Board will consider applications on a case-by-case basis. If approved, the requesting applicant must also secure a Sports Wagering Operator license through the <u>Office of Lottery and Gaming</u> which they coordinate autonomously.




