

HAWDC Member Notice:
COVID-19 Update - Updated Prohibitions on Mass Gatherings

Dear HAWDC Member:

Mayor Bowser just issued an updated Order regarding mass gatherings in order to help halt the spread of COVID-19. Pursuant to the Order:

- Mass gatherings of more than fifty (50) persons are prohibited anywhere in the District of Columbia.
 - Mass gathering does not include a licensed hotel.
- Restaurants and Taverns licensed in the District of Columbia shall suspend table seating effective March 16, 2020, at 10:00 m until April 1, 2020, at 6:00 am.
- Restaurants and Taverns may operate delivery and grab-and-go operations only, beginning on March 16, 2020, at 10:00 pm.
- Venues doing business as nightclubs, multi-purpose facilities, health clubs, health spas, massage establishments, and theaters in the District of Columbia must suspend operations on March 17, 2020.
