Metro Proposing Plan to Subsidize Late-Night Uber and Lyft Rides for Hospitality Workers:

As you may be aware, Metro is currently proposing to extend its moratorium on late-night service for at least another year to continue working on maintenance of the transportation system. As an accommodation for late-night workers working in the fields of hospitality and healthcare, traveling to and from work during the hours of midnight and 4 a.m., Metro is proposing a plan to subsidize their Uber and Lyft rides for up to 10 trips per person, per week.

Metro is expected to issue a request for proposals soon that will outline its goals for the estimated \$1 million program that would subsidized trips up to \$3 per ride. Riders would register for the program; the ridehailing companies would bill Metro for the subsidized costs, and data would be used to validate the riders' travel. Mayor Bowser strongly opposes the idea, and wants Metro to fulfill its commitment to restoring late-night hours.

Metro began with its year-long SafeTrack maintenance program in 2017 and was extended by two years. It asserts that it needs at least another year of the early closings critical preventive maintenance, which has an estimated five-year timetable.
