Public Health Emergency Extended Through May 15th

Earlier today, Mayor Bowser extended the public health emergency, stay at home order, closure of non-essential businesses, and state of emergency for the District of Columbia through **May 15, 2020**.

Clarifies that masks are required for:

- **Hotel workers, guests, and visitors;**
- Individuals using taxis, ride shares, private transportation providers;
- Workers and customers of food sellers; and
- Strongly encouraged for workers and individuals using public transit.
