Stay-At-Home Order Extended

Today, Mayor Bowser announced that the District's Stay-At-Home Order will be extended to **June 8, 2020**. However, the District is instituting a pilot program to grant waivers to educational and academic retail shops to do curbside and front door pick-up service. These stores will not be allowed to have customers inside and will be required to share data regarding sales, hours, and how they've adjusted operations. The District will use the information gained from the pilot program to determine how to safely open additional businesses.
