DC Business PPE Care Package Pickup

The reopening guidelines outline specific use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including face masks, hand sanitizer, and liquid cleaning concentrate. To help overcome the challenge of acquiring these items for reopening, the District government will provide free PPE Care Packages consisting of masks, hand sanitizer and liquid cleaning concentrate to those businesses eligible to continue operating or reopening in Phase 1, and who sign-up as described in the next paragraph.

In order to receive these complimentary PPE Care Package, businesses eligible for Phase I reopening will need to complete a PPE Sign-Up Form, by clicking [here](#). Upon completion of the PPE Sign-Up Form, the business owner will receive confirmation and instructions for pick-up (delivery is not available). Each eligible business will receive a PPE Care Package with quantities needed for about one week of operation. The supplies will be distributed in packages that may include up to 200 masks, 10 gallons of sanitizer, and 10 gallons of liquid cleaning concentrate. PPE Care Packages will be distributed on a first-come-first serve basis while supplies last.

The District of Columbia has been organized into zones to facilitate distribution of PPE Care Packages. Please find your pick-up zone by clicking [here](#). When completing the registration, you will have to select the ticket that matches your zone. Again, the complimentary PPE Care Packages will be available while supplies last. Pick-ups will begin Monday, June 1st.
