## **Travel Advisory and COVID-19 Testing**

As you are aware, the District's new travel advisory goes into effect today. The new advisory allows travelers to come to the District if they have a negative COVID-19 test within 72-hours of traveling. If a person is visiting the District for more than three days, they will also need to get tested again within 3-5 days of arrival.
