District to Lift Current Indoor Mask Mandate

Beginning Monday, November 22, 2021, the District will lift the current indoor mask mandate. Vaccinated individuals will no longer have to wear a mask indoors. ***Individual businesses and employers will still have the option to have their own mask and vaccine requirements to enter their facilities.***

Masks will still be required, regardless of vaccination status, in the following circumstances:

- Any private business that wants a mask requirement
- On public transportation like buses and trains, inside train stations, in airports, and while in ride share vehicles
- Inside schools, childcare facilities, and libraries
- Congregate facilities, such as nursing homes/assisted living facilities, shelters, dorms/residences, and correctional facilities
- At DC government facilities where there's direct interaction between employees and the public (e.g. DMV service center, DHS service center, etc.)
